

Cases referred to independent Mediators through Family Mediation Co-ordinator's Office from 01/01/2013 to 31/12/2013

In 2013, a total of 235 cases have been referred to mediators by the FMCO. As at 31 December 2013, mediation has been conducted and completed in 113 cases, of which 78 have been settled after mediation. The success rate, based on cases completed through mediation, is 69%. The duration between the date of appointing mediator to the date of completion of the whole mediation process, on average, is 83 days.

Over average, it took 15 hours to reach a full agreement, 22 hours to reach a partial agreement and 10 hours to reach no agreement.

Regarding the cost of mediated cases, it was, on average HK\$7,100 per case / HK\$500 per hour for a case with full agreement; HK\$11,100 per case / HK\$500 per hour for a case with partial agreement and HK\$7,500 per case / HK\$500 per hour for a case without agreement.

According to the record kept by FMCO, 73% of cases appointed mediators from NGOs for family mediation. These NGOs would provide mediation service with concession rate to the parties with financial difficulty.

[∨] It refers to the average duration between the date of appointing mediator to the date of completion of the whole mediation process (in days); and it is arrived by having the total number of days reported for the mediation process, divided by the number of cases with duration reported over that year.
