## Cases referred to independent Mediators through Integrated Mediation Office from 01/01/2023 to 31/12/2023

In 2023, a total of 259 cases have been referred to mediators by the IMO. As at 31 December 2023, mediation has been conducted and completed in 136 cases, of which 81 have been settled after mediation. The success rate, based on cases completed through mediation, is 60%. The duration between the date of appointing mediator to the date of completion of the whole mediation process, on average, is 102 days.

Over average, it took 12 hours to reach a full agreement, 14 hours to reach a partial agreement and 9 hours to reach no agreement.

Regarding the cost of mediated cases, it was, on average HK\$10,500 per case / HK\$900 per hour for a case with full agreement; HK\$13,400 per case / HK\$1,000 per hour for a case with partial agreement and HK\$6,100 per case / HK\$700 per hour for a case without agreement.

According to the record kept by IMO, 32% of cases appointed mediators from NGOs for family mediation. These NGOs would provide mediation service with concession rate to the parties with financial difficulty.
